Pessimistic = adj = pessimistic about something

She is always pessimistic about her grades.

cursor = something done quickly = adjective

↳ quick

Only a cursory inspection was done on the building. ↘ quick

profligate = adj = describing a person or thing

profligate Americans = wasteful Americans

profligate dog = wasteful dog

- She is a profligate spender.

miser = noun = a person

↳ cheapskate ex. The miser like to sit and play with his money.

Jocular = adjective = comes before a person or thing

She likes to make jocular remarks about people.

The jocular man is known for his ~~funny~~ jokes.
