C Currency: The timeliness of the information.

R Relevance: The importance of the information for your needs.

A Authority: The source of the information.

A Accuracy: The reliability, truthfulness and correctness of the content.

P Purpose: The reason the information exists.

Step 1:

Select one of the two questions & create a thesis statement for it:

Option 1:

Synthesize at least three of the sources in a well-organized essay where you take a position on whether immigration in the United States should be reformed.

Option 2:

Synthesize at least three of the sources in a well-organized essay where you take a position on immigration reform and provide the best solution for immigration in the United States.

Step 2:

In groups of 4 you will rotate through these sources.

- 2. Complete the CRAAP Evaluation for each of the 4 sources
- 3. Select 3 of the 4 sources that you will use to argue your position.
- 4. Create a chart like the following to collect evidence that can be used from each source
